On 10/16/2014, the Cabot Police Department received information about inappropriate contact between a Paraprofessional and a female student at the Junior High South School in Cabot. The case was immediately investigated by the Cabot Police Department Detectives. The juvenile female victim was interviewed at the Cabot Police Department about the alleged incident. A short time later, the female Paraprofessional was identified as Morgan Young, age 23 of Cabot. Immediately after the interview, Detectives made contact with Ms. Young at Junior High South. Ms. Young was taken to the Cabot Police Department Detective's Office where she was interviewed. After Ms. Young's interviewed, she was placed under arrest and booked into the Cabot Police Department Jail. Ms. Young is charged with Sexual Assualt in the 2nd Degree, which is a B Felony.

The Cabot Police Department would like to thank that Cabot Public School District Officials that assisted.

Ms. Young's first appearance in Lonoke County Circuit Court will be 10/17/2014. She currently is on a no bond hold at the Cabot Police Department Jail.
