 - A statement by the local registrar or a county recorder certifying the child's date of birth
 - An attested baptismal certificate
 - A passport
 - An affidavit of the date and place of birth by the child's parent or guardian
 - Previous school records
 - Military ID

 Copy of child's Social Security card or an alternate number will be assigned upon parental request

5. Completed "Home Language Usage Survey" Form

- The form is available in both English and Spanish
- If needed, this form is available in additional languages when registration is finalized

6. School Records

• Students who have previously attended school in another district should bring their latest report card, if available

7. Health Records

- Immunization documentation
 - If not currently available, these records must be submitted before attending school
