



Pre-K Enrollment FAQ's



- 1. How many Pre-K students can enroll?** We have positions for 340 four year olds.
- 2. How is my child's Pre-K school chosen?** Pre-k programs are offered in six (6) of our schools: Central, Magness Creek, Mountain Springs, Northside, Ward Central and Westside. Students are placed according to their address. Parents will be notified by phone regarding their child's placement.
- 3. Do all Pre-K students attend free of charge?** No. A sliding scale is used to determine a child's placement; however parents may be required to pay for breakfast/lunch if not enrolled in free/reduced meals. Some students will pay for meals. Tuition students may also attend. Breakfast and lunch are provided as part of the tuition. Tuition amount is based on income using a sliding scale from \$50-95 per week.
- 4. Does Cabot School District provide transportation?** Yes. Students are able to ride school buses. Pre-K students sit at the front of the bus nearest the driver and are signed on/off the bus by school personnel. An approved person must be present at the bus stop each morning/afternoon. Students may also be a car or day care rider.
- 5. What are the hours of operation?** Pre-K has the same hours as all schools. Students cannot be dropped off prior to 7:30 a.m. and must be picked up no later than 3:30 p.m.
- 6. When will I know where my child will attend?** Students will be placed in a classroom once a completed packet is filed. Those who have a completed packet on file will be notified by phone. Others will be notified as packets are completed. *It is vital to update your enrollment form should your phone number change.*
- 7. How will I know who is my child's teacher?** Your child's teacher will call August 6th – August 10th to introduce herself and set up a conference. Conferences are held the first day of school.
- 8. May I request a teacher?** Unfortunately, we are unable to honor all requests. If you would like to make a request, please write a note and include it in the packet.
- 9. Does Cabot School District provide afterschool care for Pre-K?** No.
- 10. What happens once all 340 slots are filled?** Students are placed on a waiting list. You will be contacted as a slot becomes available.
- 11. Why is it important to complete the packet?** A student will not be enrolled until the packet is complete.

A completed enrollment packet must have:

1. Copy of Birth Certificate
2. Copy of Social Security Card
3. Proof of income for ALL adults in the home equal to 1 month worth of pay. A No Income Statement for anyone not working.
- *4. A current shot record- the final series of shots cannot be given until after your child's 4th birthday
- *5. Physical
