## Parent & Student Homebound Information

Student Name Parent Name

To be considered for homebound instruction

- A student must have an illness or injury that prevents school attendance longer than 10 days
- Homebound instruction is needed for for less than one semester
- The condition must be documented by a medical doctor
- A completed and signed Homebound Instruction Application must be submitted to the Director of Counselina
- It is the parent's responsibility to obtain and submit the application
- Incomplete forms will not be approved
- Attendance policies continue to apply until the application is approved. It is the parent's responsibility to obtain a doctor's note for any absences not covered by the approved time for homebound services
- Submitting an application does NOT guarantee approval
- A specific length of time for services or date of return is required
- Students receiving special services should contact the Director of Special Education in order to be considered for homebound services

Information after approval

- After approval a homebound instructor will contact the parents to arrange meeting times
- Homebound services consist of a minimum of two (2) hours and a maximum of five (5) hours per week.
- The assigned homebound instructor coordinate with classroom teachers for assignments and grading
- A student can not attend school or participate in any school events while receiving homebound services
- Student schedules may be adjusted due to specific class requirements if class standards can not be • taught effectively through homebound instruction. THIS COULD AFFECT THE EXPECTED GRADUATION DATE. These courses include, but are not limited to, Pre AP, AP, foreign language, band, computer, medical, and career tech electives.
- Students receiving homebound instruction for less than four weeks may be able to continue some or all • of their current classes
- The parent is responsible for notifying the homebound instructor if the length of services need to be shortened or extended. The homebound instructor will notify the Director of Counseling.
- Services may be lengthened or shortened with documentation from the student's doctor. The parent is responsible for obtaining documentation.
- Attendance policies apply after the projected date for end of services unless the Director of Counseling has received documentation from the student's doctor to extend services. Documentation must include a specific length of time or return date.
- The student is responsible for completing assignments in a timely manner. If a student can not complete assignments by the due date, the homebound instructor should be notified immediately.
- If a student is unable to meet with the homebound instructor during the schedule time, the parent should contact the homebound instructor
- Homebound services may be discontinued due to repeated cancellations or lack of completing assignments
- Students will follow requirements for semester tests
