Grade	Curriculum Title	Short Description
2-4	G/T Math	Using both digital and analog methods, students will progress as quickly as they can through grade level standards using Khan Academy and other resources.
3-4	Hands on Equations	Students in grades 3-4 will also supplement their G/T math with the pre-algebra curriculum of Hands on Equations.
2 <sup>nd</sup>	National Parks	2 <sup>nd</sup> grade students will study the history of the national parks and their impact on our country. This unit will culminate with a visit to Hot Springs National Park.

3 <sup>rd</sup>	Go Green	This unit is an environmental science unit, which focuses on humanity's role in the ecosystem. By the end of the unit students will know much more than the three Rs.
