The 2017 Cabot Homecoming Parade will be held **Friday, September 29th** at 3:30.

Registration forms are due to Cabot High School by **Friday, September 22nd**.

Forms submitted after September 22nd, MUST be brought to the High School office and will be charged a late fee.

Payment is due with registration. Please make checks payable to: Cabot High School. All checks must have the following information written or printed on them: **Full Name, Address (No P.O. Boxes), Home Phone Number, and Work Phone Number.** The map with all entry locations will be posted online with this registration form. The parade will begin at 3:30 pm. Line-up information will be provided on the map you receive with your line up location. Participants may start lining up at 2:30, **not before**. All entries need to be at their location by 3:15. **Vehicles/ Floats assigned to Panther Trail Rd, must enter Panther Trail from Kerr Station.** In order to minimize traffic jams on Panther Trail, first we encourage car-pooling as much as possible. **Vehicles that are not actually in the parade will not be allowed on Panther Trail Rd. after 2:45.** Parents may use the parking lot for Middle School South off of Kerr Station. **All youth football and cheerleader entries will be staged at Southside Elementary. All entries will be lined up in the order they arrive.**

****Parade Route, Must Read****

The parade will begin at the intersection of Hwy 89 and Panther Trail and **end at the intersection of Hwy 89 and Pond Street.** **You must turn left at Pond Street at the end of the parade.** The police will not allow any parade participants to take another route once you've reached the intersection of Hwy 89 and Pond Street. For parents picking up children who are participating in the parade, you must make arrangements with **your organization's float coordinator** as to where to meet after the parade is over to get your child.

Bicycles, all-terrain vehicles and 18-wheel vehicles are not allowed in the parade. **For safety reasons, candy may not be thrown from any float or given out by anyone accompanying an entry.** A school administrator or Cabot police officer will immediately remove anyone throwing candy from the parade. All drivers must have a valid driver's license.

In case of rain, the parade will **NOT** be rescheduled. If the parade is cancelled due to weather, all **public entry fees** will be refunded. Any announcement of parade cancellation will be posted on the High School Marquis. Finally, on behalf of the CHS Student Council, thank you for supporting the Cabot Community and the Cabot High School Panthers! **The Panthers will be playing FS Southside, The Mavericks.**
