This year, Southside has been using the Sumdog.com website, which uses fun multiplayer games to encourage students to practice their mathematics. Students are familiar with the site and have had lots of fun practicing math concepts. Each student's user name and password will be sent home along with this letter. Southside will be launching a "Summer Math Challenge". This will be our summer math activity for students entering 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade during the 2015-2016 school year. To complete the challenge, children must correctly answer 100 questions a day for a total of 20 days out of the entire summer. Children receive 2000 bonus "Sumdog Coins" that they can use to customize their Sumdog avatar, in Sumdog's virtual shop. The students will be monitored through Sumdog's reporting component and students that complete the challenge will be recognized at a back to school celebration in August.
