# MINUTES OF THE JULY 23, 2019 BOARD OF EDUCATION CABOT SCHOOL DISTRICT

Board President Marvin Jones called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Those in attendance were school board members Brian Evans, Sarah Owen, Pam Clem, Donna Nash, and Corey Williams. Also in attendance were Dr. Tony Thurman, Michael Byrd, directors, and community members. Board member Joe Trusty was absent.

### CONSENT AGENDA

Minutes from the regular June meeting were approved as presented.

### CURRICULUM REPORT

**AP Exam Results** – Aaron Randolph presented information on the 2018-2019 AP exam results. We had 486 students who took 862 tests with 56.1% receiving a score of a 3 or higher.

GT Program Evaluation Results – Parents, students, and staff were surveyed at the end of the year through online surveys, paper surveys, and focus groups to provide feedback on the GT program. They were asked about program identification processes, parent/teacher communication, and encouragement of students through the program. Mr. Randolph reviewed the results of this feedback with the board. He also shared the goals of the GT program for the 2019-2020 school year.

**ACT Aspire Overview** – Pam Wilson presented the board with test data binders for the 2018-2019 ACT Aspire results. This information will be covered in detail in a committee meeting on August 20.

**Back to School Professional Learning** – Sherri Jennings shared that New Teacher Orientation begins July 24 with over 50 teachers. This three-day event will cover district goals, values, and culture.

**Capturing Kids Hearts** – Terena Woodruff and Rebecca Coda provided an overview of a new process that will be implemented in the middle schools and Cabot Learnin Academy this year. All staff, certified and classified, at these locations will be trained in Capturing Kids Hearts. This process focuses on connections with students and has been shown to improve attendance, decrease discipline issues, and increase academic success.

### SUPERIOTENDENT'S REPORT

**2019 Administrators Work Session** - Dr. Thurman provided an overview of the administrators work session that was held July 17<sup>th</sup> through 19<sup>th</sup>. Board members were provided an opportunity to share their favorite part of the work session. The theme for this year's session was Best is the Standard.

**Student Registration Update** – Michael Byrd reported that we continue registering new students at a rate of four families per hour. All registration, new and returning students, begins on the district website.

**Facilities Report** – Dr. Thurman provided an updated on projects going on throughout the district. A condensation issue was fixed in the cafeteria at Junior High North. The new roof at Junior High South is about 20% complete. Repairs have been finished at the roundabout behind the Central Administrative Office, and new faculty parking has been designated at Champs Hall on the high school campus. The canopy is under construction on the high school campus, and crews have been painting and replacing carpet throughout the district.
