Steps you will need to take ON OR BEFORE May 18th:

1. Fill out [THE SENIOR CHROMEBOOK PROGRAM FORM](#) in your email from Mrs. Shinn. This step needs to be done whether you are purchasing your Chromebook or not.
2. Visit the CHS Media Center and either:
 1. Pay for your Chromebook and receive your receipt of purchase.
 2. Turn your Chromebook into a school representative in the Media Center and have your name checked off the list.
 3. On or around May 20th, all Chromebooks assigned to seniors will either be taken off of district policy to be used or they will be disabled and become unusable depending on your form responses.
