

Records Destruction Notice

Cabot, AR.--Beginning August 1, 2026, the Special Education Department of the Cabot School District will start to destroy Special Education records which are six (6) years old or older. According to State and Federal guidelines, Special Education records should be destroyed within six years after a student leaves the program. If you are a former student of CPS and received Special Education services during the school year 2019-2020, you have the right to receive your records before they are destroyed. If you are a student and are requesting your records, you must be eighteen years old or older with photo ID. Special Education records will be available to you for pick up at the CPS Special Education Department located at 602 N. Lincoln, Cabot, AR 72023 for a period of time. Records can be picked up from now until July 31st, 2026. You must bring your photo identification card and will be required to complete a form.
