

Act 1039

DYSLEXIA SCREENING AND INTERVENTION

Act 1039 of 2017 requires the following:

Before July 15th, a district shall report on the website or in writing to the parents of each student the following information: the dyslexia intervention programs used during the previous school year, the number of students who received dyslexia intervention, and the total number of students identified with dyslexia.

During the 2025-2026 school year, Cabot Public Schools assessed 497 students to determine if they exhibited characteristics of dyslexia. Currently, 943 students in the Cabot Public School District have either been diagnosed with dyslexia or have been identified as exhibiting characteristics of dyslexia.

During the 2025-2026 school year, 724 students received dyslexia intervention by the Cabot School District. The district utilized BUILD and Take Flight from the Scottish Rite for Children and Soday System from Imagine Learning for dyslexia intervention in grades K-4. Soday System from Imagine Learning was used for dyslexia intervention in grades 5-12.
