**<u>Registration Information</u>**: Registration forms are only available online on the Cabot School District website. Complete the online registration form and make an online payment to Cabot Public Schools. You can access the registration form <u>here</u>.

<u>Summer School Dates</u>: Monday, June 7th - Thursday, July 1, 2021. There are 25 calendar days for Credit Recovery and Health courses to be completed. Hours and Course work for P.E. must be completed by July 22nd.

**Location:** In person in the Cabot High School Media Center and online for certain activities. P.E. students will be directed to attend at one of the CPS athletic facilities.

<u>Summer School Hours</u>: Students will attend on campus on M-Th 8:00 - 2:30 and Friday 8:00 - 11:00am. In addition, students will have the opportunity to work on their assignments at home at their leisure.

<u>Attendance</u>: Students must have access to the internet and their school-issued Chromebook to participate. Students are expected to meet on-site for all classes, other than P.E. and health (depending upon enrollment), Monday through Thursday. Students who are on track to complete courses on-time may be allowed to miss the Friday morning sessions.

<u>Curriculum</u>: APEX online learning and Google Classroom. Students work at their own pace and they may finish their courses before July 1st. Staying current in the course is critical to student success. Students will need to bring their Chromebooks with them. Each teacher may have specific class requirements that will be given to students on the first day of summer school along with a course pacing guide.
