Board President Brian Evans called the meeting to order at 5:17 p.m. Those in attendance were school board members Sarah Owen, Pam Clem, Marvin Jones, Corey Williams, and Donna Nash. Joe Trusty arrived directly before executive session. Also in attendance were Dr. Tony Thurman, Michael Byrd, directors, media, and community members.

Board member Corey Williams began the meeting by recognizing Brian Evans and Donna Nash for their 10 years of service on the Cabot School Board. This was their last meeting on the board, and they will be greatly missed.

### **CURRICULUM REPORT**

**7-12 Social Studies Update** — Mandee Carmical provided information the direction of the social studies program. A committee worked on the components of the social studies curriculum and identified any gaps from the last year. They created tests that will assess home school students if they choose to return to public school. The committee worked to make sure the district has viable curriculum for all students.

### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Child and Youth Behavioral Military and Family Life Counselor Program – Terena Woodruff introduced Terri Williams and Dan Baird with the Little Rock Air Force Base. Ms. Williams explained the counselor program that will place a counselor in our district to focus on the needs of military children. Mr. Baird will be assigned to Mountain Springs Elementary and Magness Creek Elementary. They are working on approval for an additional contract that would allow for another counselor that would service two other schools in the district.

**Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee Update** – Jordan Boris provided an overview of the work completed by the committee over the last few months. They met in January to discuss how to determine student perception of how the schools support diversity. The committee decided a survey would be a good indicator. Administrators nominated students to be representatives on this committee. The plan is to distribute the survey in September.

**Buildings and Grounds Report** – Michael Byrd reported that we are still waiting on materials for some of the canopy repairs. Renovations on the health services building and

ACE/ALE are scheduled to begin when school dismisses. This summer maintenance will be working on drainage issues and replacing or repairing awnings at several campuses. Northside will receive a roof repair on the old portion of building. Work will be done at the Middle School South gyms to help waterproof them. A plumbing project will be completed at Champs Hall and a couple of locations will receive flooring replacement.
