PLC Update – Aaron Randolph shared a presentation with the board that was presented by the district at a state PLC meeting last week.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

School Board Policy Sections 1-8 Review – Dr. Thurman reviewed some of the changes in policies for the 2023-2024 school year. Many of these changes were required due to legislation passed at the recent legislative session.

2023-2024 Athletic Handbook Review – This item was tabled.

Facility Use Policy Review – Michael Byrd presented the changes to the facility use agreement. One of the biggest changes is that liability insurance must be presented to rent a facility upon reservation or the reservation will not be confirmed. Custodial, supervisor, and security fees are now tied to the pay scale rather than a set amount.

Review of Refunding and Construction Bonds – Series 2023A – Jack Truemper with Stephens, Inc. reviewed the recent bond refunding and construction bonds. Robert W. Baird & Company won the bond refunding and construction bonds at a rate of 4.242824%.
