MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 15, 2023 BOARD OF EDUCATION CABOT SCHOOL DISTRICT

Board President Sarah Owen called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. Those in attendance were school board members Pam Clem, Joe Trusty, Corey Williams, James Hertzog, and Kevin Tipton. Also, in attendance were Dr. Tony Thurman, Michael Byrd, directors, and community members. Board member Marvin Jones was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance and moment of silence were led by Jacob Fox with Cabot Church of Christ.

CONSENT AGENDA

Minutes from the regular July 17th and special called August 7th meetings were approved as presented. July financials were approved as presented. Motion by Joe Trusty, second by James Hertzog; passed 6-0.

RECOGNITION

Backpack for Kids Program — Jacob Fox and TJ Davidson from Cabot Church of Christ presented the district with a \$10,000 check for the backpack program. The Cabot Church of Christ has raised money each year the last 18 years to provide for students in need.

CURRICULUM REPORT

PLC/Student Academic Performance Report – Aaron Randolph reported that the district administered 882 AP exams last year. These exams are taken by students enrolled in AP classes in 10th through 12th grade. A score of 3 or above provides college credit for these students. The district had a 62% success rate on the exams.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Buildings and Grounds Report – Michael Byrd reported that there are currently 181 active works orders, but maintenance has closed 814 work orders in the last 30 days. The most common work orders are HVAC related. Drywall is going up a Cabot Learning Academy, and the basketball court has been poured. The band tower at the high school is installed and in use. Most of the interactive panels throughout the district have been installed. The upgrades at Fine Arts began on August 9, and inclusive playgrounds will begin installation in September. The multi-use pavilion is in its final steps of approval.

Legal Transfer Approvals – Dr. Thurman reported that 8 students were approved for outgoing legal transfers and 15 students were approved for incoming legal transfers.
