CURRICULUM REPORT

PLC/Student Academic Performance Report – Alana Graham reported that in the 2022-2023 school year Cabot Freshman Academy students had over 95% credit passage rate for all four core subjects. Junior high summer school was direct instruction focused on math and literacy, and there were 53 students registered. High school summer school had 165 students, and math and English had the highest number of participants for credit recovery.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Buildings and Grounds Report – Michael Byrd shared that the new damage from the recent storms a few weeks ago will be covered by insurance and the materials have been ordered. Contractors are working on sheet rock at Cabot Learning Academy, and they are widening the road and installing sidewalks by the facility. The summer flooring project is on punch list items now. The band tower is in production. The district has been working with the city of Austin on the training center site. The building at that site will be moved to the track facility on Bellamy. The interactive panel installation is going well, and upgrades have started in Panther Arena.

2022-2023 Year End Financial Report – Dr. Thurman reviewed the 2022-2023 financial report. The district was able to provide a raise and stay in a very healthy percentage legal balance percentage.

Legal Transfer Approvals – Dr. Thurman reported that 10 students were approved for outgoing legal transfers and 1 student was approved for an incoming legal transfer.
