- All students when exiting their vehicle from sophomore parking should use the crosswalk NOT the roundabout!

- Sophomores must be parked in the two sophomore lots across the street at all times.

- Students parking in the FIELDHOUSE lot **MUST** park in assigned spots. ANY person(s) in an inappropriate spot will be assigned Saturday School. Per HH
- Parking Passes purchased online can be picked up during both lunches. Students needing to purchase a parking pass can still purchase it online, or may do so in the front office, but you will need to get the parking pass form in the office before buying one filled out and signed by parents during both lunches. Passes are \$25, CASH or CHECK ONLY. If you have a parking permit and you get to school late you may have to park across the street in the sophomore parking lot if no spots are available in the main parking lot.
- If you need a student ID or textbooks, come by the Media Center during zero hour or during your lunch.
- **STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARK AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER OR VICTORY BAPTIST CHURCH PARKING LOTS.**
- All posters, flyers or club meetings must be approved by Mr. Hawkins first to hang or post on the walls.
- **All students** are to use the raised crosswalk when you cross the street in front of the CAO building from sophomore lots. Do not use the roundabout crossing. HH
