CURRICULUM REPORT

Secondary Honors Transition — Aaron Randolph shared information on the transition from Pre-AP classes to honors classes for the district. College Board has made some changes to the Pre-AP class curriculum and types of classes offered that will go into effect in the fall of 2022. They do not offer all of the pre-AP classes we currently offer with this change. In order to offer the best curriculum for our students, the district has decided to forgo the College Board Pre-AP program and transition to an honors curriculum.

ESSA Scores Report – Aaron Randolph provided information about ESSA scores. ESSA is the Every Student Succeeds Act, and analyzes the following five indicators for success: achievement, growth, English learner progress toward English language proficiency, graduation rate, and school quality and student success (SQSS). Central Elementary and Mountain Springs Elementary demonstrated growth even through the pandemic. ACE was one of only two schools in Arkansas to see double digit growth in their ESSA scores.
