Overview

Interview



- Each student will have a face-to-face interview with a school official to determine if CPDA is the best fit for the student.

- Students will participate in social emotional and hands on learning opportunities.

Assessments



- Students will come to campus to take assessments such as NWEA MAP, ACT/ACT Aspire, and grade level assessments.
- Administrators and teachers reserve the right to request your student's presence on campus if deemed necessary.

Intervention



- Students will meet in small groups or one-on-one with their teacher for a designated intervention time throughout the week.
- If the teacher determines the student needs face-to-face intervention, the student will be asked to come on campus to participate in intervention.
