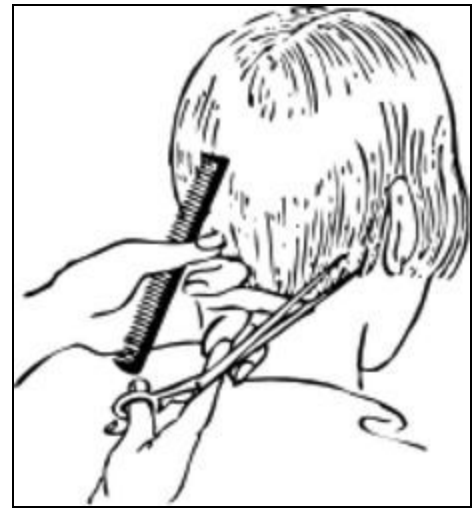
Read the following passage and answer the question(s) below.
